

Cookies policy

1. Introduction

This document describes how we use cookies and similar technologies on our Service (hereinafter — the "**Service**"). Cookies are small text files that are stored on your device when you visit a website.

By using the Service, you agree to the use of cookies in accordance with this policy.

2. What are cookies?

A cookie is a text file containing a small amount of data which:

- Is exchanged between your browser and our servers
 - Is stored on your device (computer, smartphone, tablet)
 - Can be read by the website that created it
 - Helps websites remember information about you
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3. Types of cookies

3.1 By lifetime

Session cookies:

- Are deleted automatically when the browser is closed
- Are used to store information temporarily during your visit
- Do not require separate consent for essential functions

Persistent cookies:

- Remain on your device after the browser is closed
- May last for several days, months or years
- Require separate consent

3.2 By origin

First-party cookies:

- Are set by our Service
- Can be read only by our website
- For example: `example.com` can create only its own cookies

Third-party cookies:

- Are set by other services (analytics, payments)
 - Can be read by other sites
 - Require the user's explicit consent
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4. Categories of cookies we use

4.1 Essential (mandatory) cookies

These cookies are **necessary** for the Service to work correctly and **do not require consent**.

They include:

- Identification of your session and authentication
- Protection against attacks (CSRF protection)
- Storage of your basic preferences (language, interface theme)
- Securing access to the API

Lifetime: From the end of the session up to 1 year, depending on the type

4.2 Functional cookies

Improve convenience and the personalisation of the user experience. **Require consent**.

They include:

- Remembering your preferences and settings
- The state of the interface (expanded/collapsed, open panels)
- Storing the history of your actions in the current session
- Personalisation of how content is displayed

Lifetime: Usually from several days up to 1 year

4.3 Analytics cookies

Help us understand how users use the Service and where we can improve it. **Require consent**.

They include:

- Tracking the number of visits and users
- Analysis of the time spent on different pages
- Identification of popular features and sections
- Collection of information about device and browser types

The data is used only to:

- Improve the performance of the Service
- Fix problems with functionality
- Analyse anonymised user behaviour

Lifetime: From 1 day to 2 years, depending on the analytics service

Providers: May include third-party analytics services

4.4 Payment system cookies

Used by payment providers when processing payments and paying for services.

They include:

- Identification of the payment session
- Fraud prevention and payment security
- Processing and confirmation of the payment
- Compliance with payment system security requirements

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5. How to manage cookies

5.1 Managing cookies in your browser

Google Chrome:

1. Open Settings → Privacy and security → Cookies and other site data
2. Select the options you need:
 - Allow all cookies
 - Block third-party cookies
 - Block all cookies

Mozilla Firefox:

1. Open Settings → Privacy & Security
2. In the "Cookies" section, choose the level of protection you need

Safari (macOS/iOS):

1. Settings → Privacy
2. Tick "Block all cookies" and choose the level

Microsoft Edge:

1. Settings → Privacy → Clear browsing data
2. Select "Cookies and other site data"

5.2 Managing cookies on our Service

On your first visit to the Service you will be asked for consent to the use of cookies. You may:

- **Accept all** — allow the use of all types of cookies
- **Essential only** — use only the mandatory cookies
- **Manage preferences** — select specific categories

5.3 Declining cookies

If you decline cookies (other than the essential ones), this may result in:

- A reduced quality of the user experience
 - Some features being unavailable
 - **However:** the Service remains fully functional without functional and analytics cookies
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6. What data can be entrusted to cookies?

6.1 What data is stored in cookies

Typically stored:

- Session and authentication identifiers
- Your interface preferences and settings
- Information about your use of the Service (which features you use)
- Analytics data about behaviour (anonymised)

NOT stored in cookies:

- Passwords or authentication keys
- Full personal data
- The content of your requests and their results
- Financial information (card numbers, payment details)

6.2 Cookie security

All cookies on our Service:

- Are transmitted only over **HTTPS** (a secure connection)
 - Are marked with the **HttpOnly** flag (inaccessible to JavaScript)
 - Are marked with the **Secure** flag (transmitted only over HTTPS)
 - Are marked with the **SameSite** flag (protection against CSRF attacks)
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7. Your rights and consent to cookies

7.1 How we obtain consent

- A cookie banner on your first visit
- Explicit consent is required for functional and analytics cookies
- Declining does not restrict access to the Service (other than optimisations)

7.2 How long consent is valid

- Once given, consent is valid for **1 year**
- You may withdraw your consent at any time in the settings

7.3 Your rights in respect of data collected through cookies

The rights of access, rectification, erasure and withdrawal of consent in respect of personal data, including data collected through cookies, are described in section 8 of our **Privacy Policy**.

8. Third-party cookies

8.1 Analytics services

We may use third-party analytics services to analyse the use of the Service. These services may set their own cookies in order to:

- Track user sessions
- Collect information about behaviour on the site
- Analyse the effectiveness of features

You can manage your consent to these cookies in the preferences management section.

8.2 Payment systems

When you make a payment, Robokassa, CloudPayments and the other payment providers we use may set their own cookies in order to:

- Prevent fraud
- Secure the payment
- Comply with payment system security requirements

They will process your data in accordance with their own privacy policies.

9. How long are cookies stored?

Session cookies: are deleted automatically when the browser is closed

Persistent cookies:

- Essential: **30 days - 1 year**
- Functional: **90 days - 1 year**
- Analytics: **24 hours - 2 years**

You can delete cookies manually through your browser settings.
